Back to School / Me & My Body / Family / Seasons and Weather

Students will begin the road to becoming independent, active and inquisitive Learners."

In Kinder Heart, we strive to create an environment where your child feels safe and secure.

<u>Skills</u>

- During the 1st Term children will begin to investigate patterns and experiment with puzzles..
- We will begin to explore problem solving skills through a variety of investigating and sorting games.

Learn Social Skills

- **Rules and good behaviour**
- I How to express and communicate their needs.
- Good hygiene care ; how to wash and keep their work and play area clean.
- I How to separate from their main caregiver.
- [] Children will gain confidence through performance and social interactions.
- Children will develop confidence for swimming and begin to become confident swimmers at their own pace.

Independence

- Parents can help children adjust easier by allowing them some opportunities to take responsibilities.
- Coming to school and going home are very important. A routine that the children begin to expect helps them to adjust better and easier.

Please note that an extra emphasis will be placed on clean habits both with themselves and their environment.

Organizational skills self-confidence and personal responsibility are a key to becoming a successful student and person.

Communication

Students will expand their language and conversation skills though social interactions and role playing activities. Your child will be exposed daily to new vocabulary related to the monthly topics.

They will begin to be able to begin to pronounce and identify the letters a, b, c, d, e

Children will begin to understand books as stories and use their imagination to consider what the story might be.
